

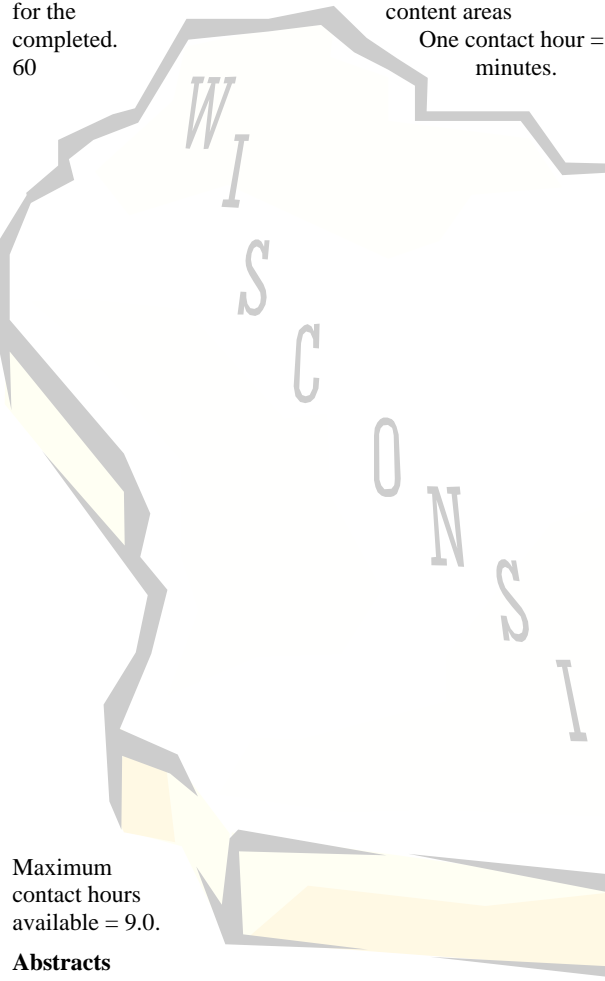
**Program Goal**

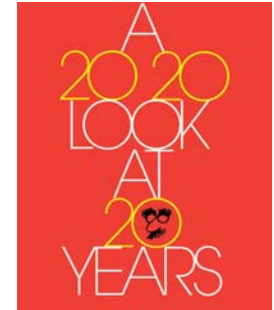
